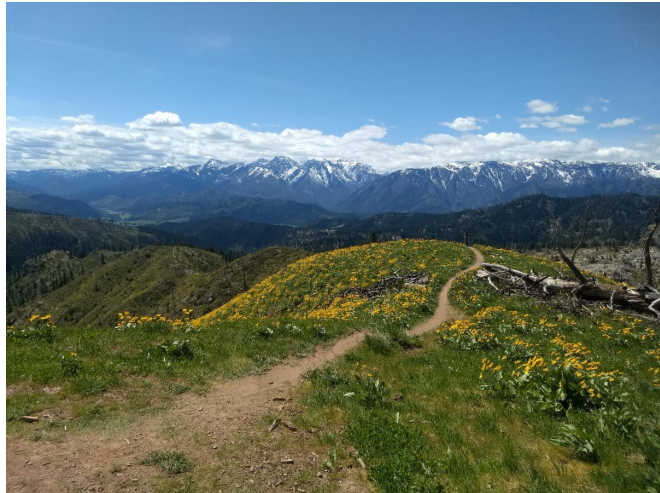

LWCF Needs Full and Permanent Funding: Tell Congress to ACT NOW!

Happy Thanksgiving! We are thankful for The Mountain Pact communities, our partnerships with you, and our collective work. Let's stand together and tell Congress how thankful we are for America's public Lands, and how important it is to preserve America's public lands legacy.



Last week, the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee took an exciting step towards finalizing permanent funding for the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF). The Land and Water Conservation Fund Permanent Funding Act ([S. 1081](#)) passed out of the committee with a vote of 13-7, with Republican Senators Gardner, Daines, Alexander and McSally joining all the Committee Democrats in voting yes.

It is important to keep the pressure on your Senators and Representatives so that [America's best conservation program](#) can receive, full, permanent, and dedicated funding. LWCF has remained drastically underfunded for decades and has been a target of the Trump administration. The president's FY20 budget suggests zeroing out LWCF and the Senate Republicans recently voted on an Interior appropriations bill that allocated less than half the full funding level of \$900 million.

We must maintain the momentum by asking for **full and permanent funding for the Land and Water Conservation Fund NOW!** Call your Senators and Representatives and ask them to support the future of America's best conservation program by pushing leadership to move forward with a vote on LWCF funding either through a budget deal or with a vote on the floor.
