The Mountain Pact is Supportive of the Effort to Expand the San Gabriel Mountains National Monument

DURANGO, CO - In response to California Senator Alex Padilla and Representative Judy Chu, along with local elected officials and community leaders calling for President Biden to expand the San Gabriel Mountains National Monument, <u>The Mountain Pact</u>, released the below statement:

National monuments and their designations are incredibly bi-partisan. Congress passed the <u>Antiquities Act</u> in 1906 and since then, 18 presidents - nine Democratic and nine Republican - have established or expanded <u>161</u> <u>national monuments</u>.
